File #LUA2022-0012: The City of Kelso is undergoing a project to rebuild the outdated Donation Pump Station located on North 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The new wastewater pump station will be built on the footprint of the existing pump station. However, the existing pump station already encroaches into the required front yard setback. Thus, a variance is requested for the new pump station to also encroach into the setback. The project also involves replacing the existing 8-inch force main within 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue with a 16-inch HDPE force main running south from the pump station approximately 1,150 lineal feet. The site is on North 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and starts immediately south of 400 Donation St.
